Shacks burn to the ground

Numerous shack fires were reported only days apart

A woman died and four other homes were destroyed in Ermelo and Breyten in separate fire incidents only days apart.

The 27-year-old woman died after her shack caught fire in Steve Biko Informal Settlement, Wesselton on Monday, 17 May.

According to Mr Mandla Zwane, spokesman for the Msukaligwa Municipality, the fire broke out at about 3am.

The cause of the fire is still under investigation.

“The police found the burnt-down shack and upon closer inspection, found the body of the woman who died in the fire.”

According to paramedics who attended the scene, they were dispatched at about 4.45am. He added that members of the community rushed to help extinguish the fire, but it was unfortunately too late.

The Msukaligwa Fire and Rescue Services in Breyten were also dispatched to a shack in KwaZanele at about 2.31pm on 17 May.

The home was completely destroyed in the fire, but fortunately no one was injured. Another shack burned down in Mabuza

informal settlement on Sunday, 16 May.

According to Mr Zwane, the shack caught on fire due to a veld fire in the area.

“Msukaligwa Fire and Rescue Services attended the scene, and no injuries were reported.” He added that the owner of the shack is still unknown.

Msukaligwa Fire and Rescue Services also attended a house fire in Magagula Street.

Mr Zwane added that the fire broke out after children, who were allegedly left unattended, played with a gas bottle.

“The one-bedroom house was damaged, but fortunately no injuries were reported.”

As winter approaches many families are looking for ways to heat their homes.

Msukaligwa Fire and Rescue Services urged residents to take safety precautions, to protect their families against home fires and carbon monoxide poisoning.

“Fires, burns and carbon monoxide poisoning are significant dangers associated with heating homes, and families can help reduce their risk of being injured with easy simple actions.”

Residents are requested to report any fire incident to the emergency call centre at 017 801 3400.

Police need help finding 'Max'

Ermelo Police are looking for information pertaining to the whereabouts of Mr Maxwell "Max" Bongumusa Khumalo in connection with a stabbing on 10 February.

According to Sgt Wonder Thomo of the Ermelo Police Station, a colleague of Mr Khumalo, Mr Mkhuleko Makhosonke Nkosi, was stabbed at a retail store.

Mr Nkosi was admitted to the Ermelo Provincial Hospital,

and was fortunate to survive the ordeal. He has in the meantime been discharged.

Police are urging anyone with information about the incident and any leads to find Mr Khumalo, to contact them.

According to Sgt Thomo, Mr Khumalo was staying with family in town before the incident.

Bail denied for man accused of setting shack on fire

A 35-year-old man from Nkanini in Carolina was denied bail after he was arrested on 24 November last year in connection with attempted murder, arson and violation of a protection order.

According to Sgt Thabang Mokwana, spokesman for Carolina Police, the man allegedly locked his wife and two children, aged five and seven, in their shack, poured petrol over their

home and set it alight.

Neighbours who heard the commotion, extinguished the fire and rescued the family.

They were admitted to Carolina Hospital. "The suspect also sustained burns and was admitted to the hospital where he was kept under police guard."

He appeared in the Carolina Magistrate's Court after he was released from the hospital and was denied bail.

Illegal fires can land you a fine of up to R1 500

Winter is looming and this is typically accompanied by illegal open fires being made - whether to brave the cold or merely to clear a property of dry garden waste.

This however, is not allowed under the municipal bylaws and also constitutes a criminal offence in the case of a fire spreading and endangering the interests of others.

Regardless thereof, it is still common practice in Ermelo.

Enshrined in the South African Constitution, section 24 of the Bill of Rights speaks to everyone's right to (a) an environment that is not harmful to their health or wellbeing; and

(b) to have the environment

protected, for the benefit of present and future generations, through reasonable legislative and other measures that—

- (i) prevent pollution and ecological degradation;
- (ii) promote conservation; and
- (iii) secure ecologically sustainable development and use of natural resources while promoting justifiable economic and social development.

According to Mr Mandla Zwane, spokesman for the Msukaligwa Municipality and Msukaligwa Fire and Rescue Services, the fire services have seen an increase in reports being made about people starting fires in the open.

"Several instances of residents burning grass and garden waste

without obtaining written permission from the fire service have been received," Mr Zwane said.

"The fire services wishes to advise and warn the community that it is illegal to burn any grass or rubbish in the open air without obtaining permission. "In the event where the fire services have to be dispatched to a fire, and it is found that an open fire was started without the necessary authorisation, the owner of the stand or individual responsible for the fire, will be billed for the attendance of the fire brigade and also face a fine of R1 500. The cooperation of the community in this regard will be appreciated and any person witnessing a person making a fire, can contact the emergency call centre to report it."

Man slits woman's throat during argument



The Mpumalanga High Court in Middelburg sentenced Zikalala Emanuel Freddy (25) to 15 years' imprisonment for murder on 3 May.

According to Sgt Thabang Mokwana, spokesman for Carolina Police, Zikalala murdered his girlfriend during an argument on 3 March 2019.

On the day of the incident, Zikalala - who was 23 years old, reported to the Carolina Police to inform them that

he killed his girlfriend, Ms Gracious Siphesihle Myeni.

Zikalala accompanied the police to the scene, behind Silobela Stadium, where he pointed out her body.

She had stab wounds to her head and face and he had slit her throat with a knife.

She was certified dead by paramedics at the scene.

Zikalala was arrested after he confessed to the killing of his girlfriend.

The accused pleaded guilty in court.

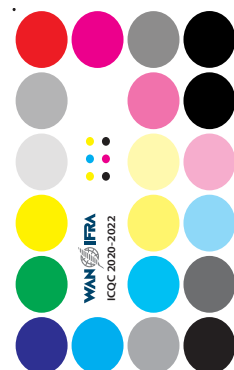

Bekende motorfietsrenjaer se ma vertel oor haar avontuurlustige seun, George

Mnr. George de la Rosa (31) is op Saterdag, 8 Mei, in 'n motorfietsongeluk op Heidelberg oorlede.

Hy het aan die GXCC (Gauteng Xross Country Club) se derde ronde van die veldfietswedren deelgeneem.

Hy het tydens dié wedren beheer van sy motorfiets verloor, van die pad afgery en teen 'n muur van 'n plaasdam gebots.

Medici het hom op die toneel gestabiliseer en hy is per helikopter na die Netcare Milpark Hospitaal in Johannesburg gevlieg.

Mnr. De la Rosa is egter kort na sy aankoms by die hospitaal dood verklaar.

Hy was 'n bekende gesig in Ermelo en die nuus van sy skielike afsterwe het skolgolwe deur die gemeenskap gestuur.

Sy ma, me. Priscilla de la Rosa, het vertel dat hy in 2007 by Ligbron Akademie vir Tegnologie matrikuleer het en het ná skool na Secunda waar hy begin werk het, verhuis het.

Hy het reeds van 'n jong ouderdom 'n groot liefde vir motorfiets gehad en het aan verskeie wedrenne deelgeneem.

Ná elke gebreekte arm en selfs baie ernstige beserings, het hy sy ouers keer op keer aan hom laat belowe dat hulle nie sy motorfiets sal verkoop nie.

Sy het vertel dat hy selfs terwyl hy nog

in die hospitaal was - kort nadat hy sy rug tydens 'n vorige voorval gebreek het, vir hulle 'n wolhaarstorie vertel het dat sy dokter kwansuis gesê het hy mag weer ry.

“Georgie was avontuurlustig, maar het absoluut gelewe vir sy dogtertjie, Kaytlin - wat ook saam met haar pa aan motorfietswedrenne deelgeneem het.”

Hy het altyd seker gemaak dat sy goed voorbereid was vir haar wedrenne en het nie een van hulle gemis nie.

Oor sy ongeluk het me. De la Rosa vertel dat dit 'n hoë-risiko sport is en dat hulle maar altyd bekommerd was wanneer hy deelgeneem het.

Sy ma het vertel dat hy tydens een van sy vorige wedrenne, lelike brandwonde aan sy arm - met die water van sy fiets se verkoeler, opgedoen het, maar steeds aan die wedren deelgeneem het.

Sy arm is met verbande toegedraai, en teen alle verwagtinge, het hy dié wedren gewen.

“Hy het hom nooit deur enige iets laat onderkry nie, en het altyd dit wat hy begin het, klaargemaak.”

Volgens haar, het hy en sy pa, wyle mnr. Flip de la Rosa, voor sy pa se afsterwe 'n waterstaander begin bou, sodat hy in die water met sy motorfiets kon ry.

Ná sy pa se dood, was hy gemotiveerd

om dit klaar te maak ter nagedagtenis aan sy pa en het reeds die motorfiets gekoop waarmee hy op die water sou ry.

Mnr. De la Rosa was ook deel van die Vans-motorfietsspan van Middelburg.

Sy spanmaat, mnr. Nick Wells, het aan

die *Hoëvelder* vertel dat hulle hom altyd sal onthou as iemand wat uit sy pad sou gaan om ander te help.

“Hy was een van die top deelnemers in ons span en het baie vir die span beteken, ons is een groot familie gewees.”

Three patients seriously injured

Three patients were seriously injured after a multi-vehicle accident on the N11 in front of the Wesselton/Boxer Shopping Centre on 14 May.

According to paramedics who attended the scene, they were dispatched at about 7.20am.

Three vehicles, a Chevrolet Aveo Ls, a minibus taxi and a small truck were involved in the collision.

The truck overturned and came to a standstill on its side.

Two of the occupants of the Chevrolet were seriously injured and transported to hospital by the Provincial Ambulance Services.

The extent of injuries - according to a paramedic, was possible head- and spinal trauma. Another occupant from the Chevrolet - with broken ribs, was transported to hospital by Igagu Emergency Medical Services.

Occupants of the taxi and truck did not sustain any serious injuries.

Information on what transpired was not available to the *Highvelder* at the time of going to press.

According to information received from medical personnel, the Chevrolet was travelling towards town when the accident occurred.

Msulaligwa Fire and Rescue Services, the local traffic department, as well as towing services were also at the scene.

Morgenzon se paaie bly 'n trekpleister

'n Poging is aangewend om Morgenzon-inwoners se dilemma met vragmotorbestuurders wat steenkool via die dorp vervoer, te besleg.

'n Vergadering met die rolspelers het op Donderdag 22 April plaasgevind.

Die agtergrond tot die ongelukkigheid is die konstruksie aan die R35, wat deel is van die Sanral-netwerk, wat met die R39 verbind.

Vragmotorbestuurders gebruik nou die dorp se paaie wat, volgens 'n sakeman van die dorp, mnr. Corné van Dijk, vernietigende gevolge het.

Hul getal staan op 'n duisend vragmotors, wat daagliks deur Morgenzon na Majuba Kragstasie ry.

Sanral het een verteenwoordiger na die vergadering gestuur, Eskom vier senior beamptes en die gemeenskap, sakelui, boere en wykraadslid het omstreeks 10.30vm begin vergader.

Die voorsitterstoel is deur 'n Eskom-beampte ingeneem, wat 'n voorstel gemaak het dat 'n klein komitee gereeld in die toekoms byeenkom om sake te bespreek.

Eskom gaan ook die vragmotorlading verminder en 'n bestekopname sal gedoen word van die beskadigde stormwaterdreine.

Die paaie gaan ook geskraap word, hoewel mnr. Van Dijk dit betwyfel of dit by diep dongas sal help.

Volgens 'n dokument van die kragvoorsiener, sien hulle die klagtes van die boere en gemeenskappe in 'n ernstige lig en is genoop om op te tree.

Nie slegs verkeersregulasies word verontagsaam nie, maar ook hul eie padvervoerreëls. Vragmotorbestuurders wat skuldig bevind word, sal met ingang van 26 April geskors word tot bewys van wettige optrede gelewer kan word.

'n Vorige vergadering met Sanral, Eskom

en die gemeenskap het op 'n dooiepunt uitgeloop toe geen verteenwoordiger van Sanral opgedaag het nie.

Mnr. Van Dijk het by meer as een geleentheid die inwoners se frustrasie, misnoë en woede verwoord en het op Saterdag 17 April gesê dat dinge in absolute chaos verval het.

Hy het destyds twee vroe geopper, naamlik wat is die korttermynplan vir Morgenzon en wat is die langtermynplan?

"Munisipale paaie word as alternatief gebruik en munisipale eiendom word beskadig," het hy ook gesê.

"Rioolwerke word verwoes en stormwaterskade aangerig."

Vragmotorbestuurders parkeer ook in die woongebied om te oornag en gebruikte kondome is sigbaar die volgende oggend, hoewel daar nie in dié stadium 'n wesenlike prostitusieprobleem is nie.

Mnr. Van Dijk was van mening dat Eskom die vragmotorbestuurders moet 'police'.

"Ons mense is keelvol," het hy benadruk. Inwoners het daad by die woord gevoged deur op 18 Maart die toegangsroete vir vragmotorbestuurders te versper.

Die Standerton Advertiser se dekking van die situasie op ons buurdorp is op die webtuiste www.ridgetimes.co.za beskikbaar.

'n E-pos is op 12 Maart om 10.12vm na me. Priya Pillay, hoof van korporatiewe kommunikasie by Sanral, gestuur.

Terugvoer is om 10.36vm ontvang dat die navraag na die 'Press Office' verwys is.

Geen kommentaar is sedertdien ontvang nie. "Die vergadering op 22 April was redelik produktief en ons kon al ons griewe opper," het mnr. Van Dijk gesê.

"Daar is egter nie heeltemal erken dat hul swak beplanning die oorsaak van ons probleme is nie."

Hy het die hoop uitgespreek dat dit nie bloot leë beloftes sal wees nie, maar dat iets goed daaruit sal spruit.

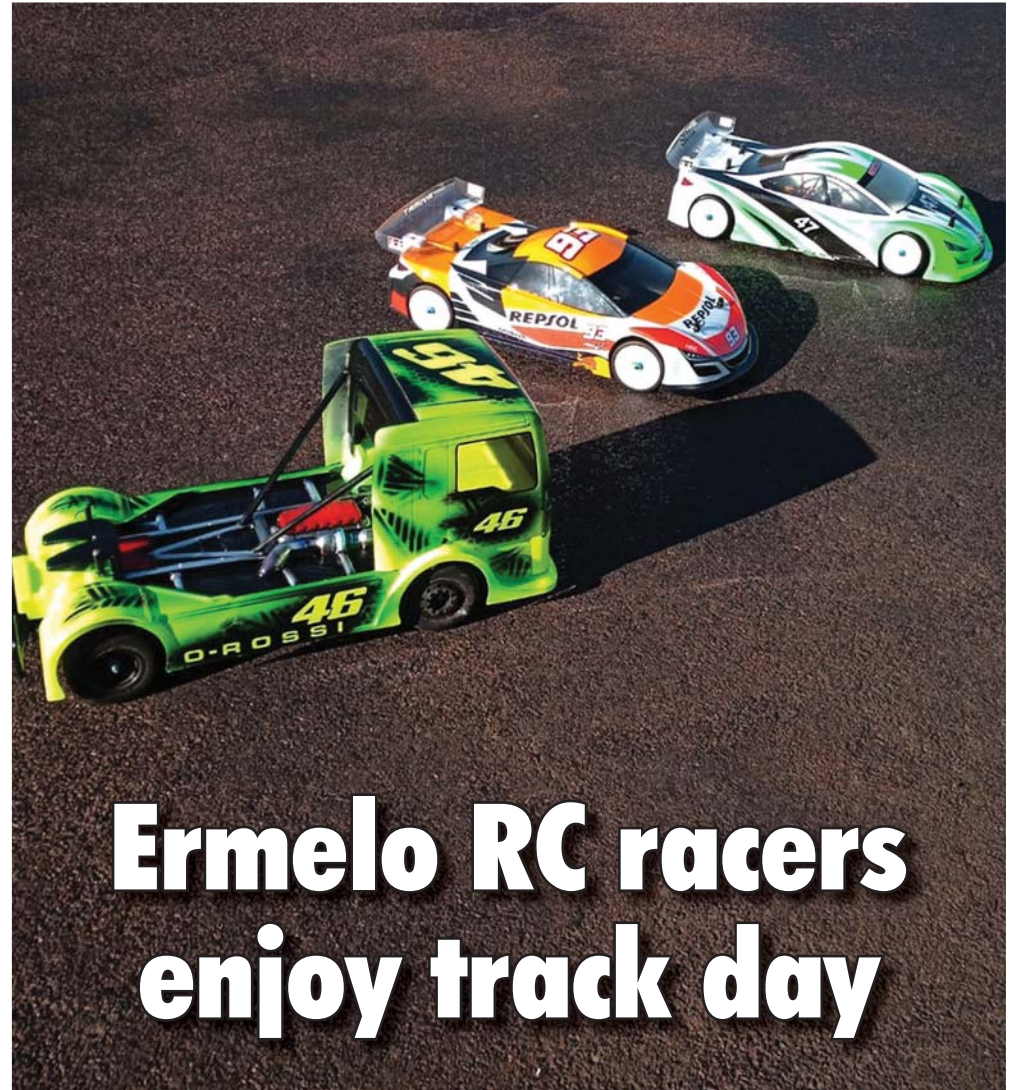

Equestrians saddle-up for NBHA Barrel Race

Equestrians from near and far are galloping to Badplaas Forever Resorts Arena to compete in the National Barrel Horse Association's (NBHA) Double Qualifier Barrel Race Event on 29 May.

These qualifiers are in preparation for the South African Championship at the end of the year.

Proceedings will begin at 9am where riders will have two runs to put up their best times.

After this qualifier, there will be a fun Coca Cola-race.

Riders are up against the clock and have to make their way around a barrel with cold drinks placed on it, grab a cold drink and then sprint back to the starting point.

Ms Charlene Oosthuizen, managing

director of NBHA South Africa, said they aim to make the event as fun as possible for equestrians, horses and onlookers alike.

"We have therefore also scheduled a pole-bending event after the Coca Cola-race, which is a timed event that features a horse and one mounted rider, running a weaving or serpentine path around six poles arranged in a line. The horses then get ample time to take a breather before the second qualifier - which will be a night race, begins.

According to Ms Oosthuizen, these night barrel races get the riders' adrenaline pumping and is conducive for peak performance from the horses as the temperatures are much cooler.

Members of the NBHA will earn points as they participate and must collect enough

points to be eligible to qualify for the South African Championship Barrel Race. Participation equals points and additional points are earned according to the riders' results on the given day.

You do not have to be a member of the NBHA to participate in these events, and if you like it, you still have seven days after the event to join and still earn your points.

"We love kids and new riders, they do not have to be professionals, we like to help beginners and just want them to enjoy it."

NBHA South Africa was started with an initiative to grow barrel racing as a sport in South Africa, to provide riders with an opportunity to compete and to represent South Africa on an international level.

NBHA is the gateway for barrel racers in

South Africa to compete in major events all over the world.

The NBHA South African component is a registered NPO and all funds raised goes back to its members in the form of prizes and to grow the sport in South African with youth programmes and clinics.

"We want to keep the sport alive and need everyone's support to grow it.

"There's a lot of hard work going on behind the scenes to arrange something like this and people who work here, are all volunteers sacrificing their own time to make it happen.
